

NO MAJORETTE IS B. C. RULING

VANCOUVER, B. C., Nov. 13. (AP) —A high-stepping drum majorette in spangled shorts withdrew from the Remembrance day parade here at the request of the parade marshal.

Elaine Harris, who was leading the 200 male marchers of the American Legion university post No. 11 of Seattle, left the parade shortly before it reached the downtown cenotaph Saturday.

The rule here is that only women who actually were in the services march in the parade.

"Our American friends look on the occasion a bit differently," said parade marshal C. E. Palmer. "With them it's more of a holiday or victory celebration. With us it is more remembrance."
