Salem police said today that when the group returned to the Hoover Elementary School gymnasium at 1:25 a.m. today, to spend the night, they found they had been robbed of \$1,018 worth of clothes, watches, tape recorders and tapes, hair dryers and some cash.

The gym apparently had been left unlocked, police said, when the corps went to compete in the contest on the Sprague High School football field. The Conquistadors were among nine corps in the Classic. The host group, the Argonauts, was not entered, having disbanded last May for lack of membership.
