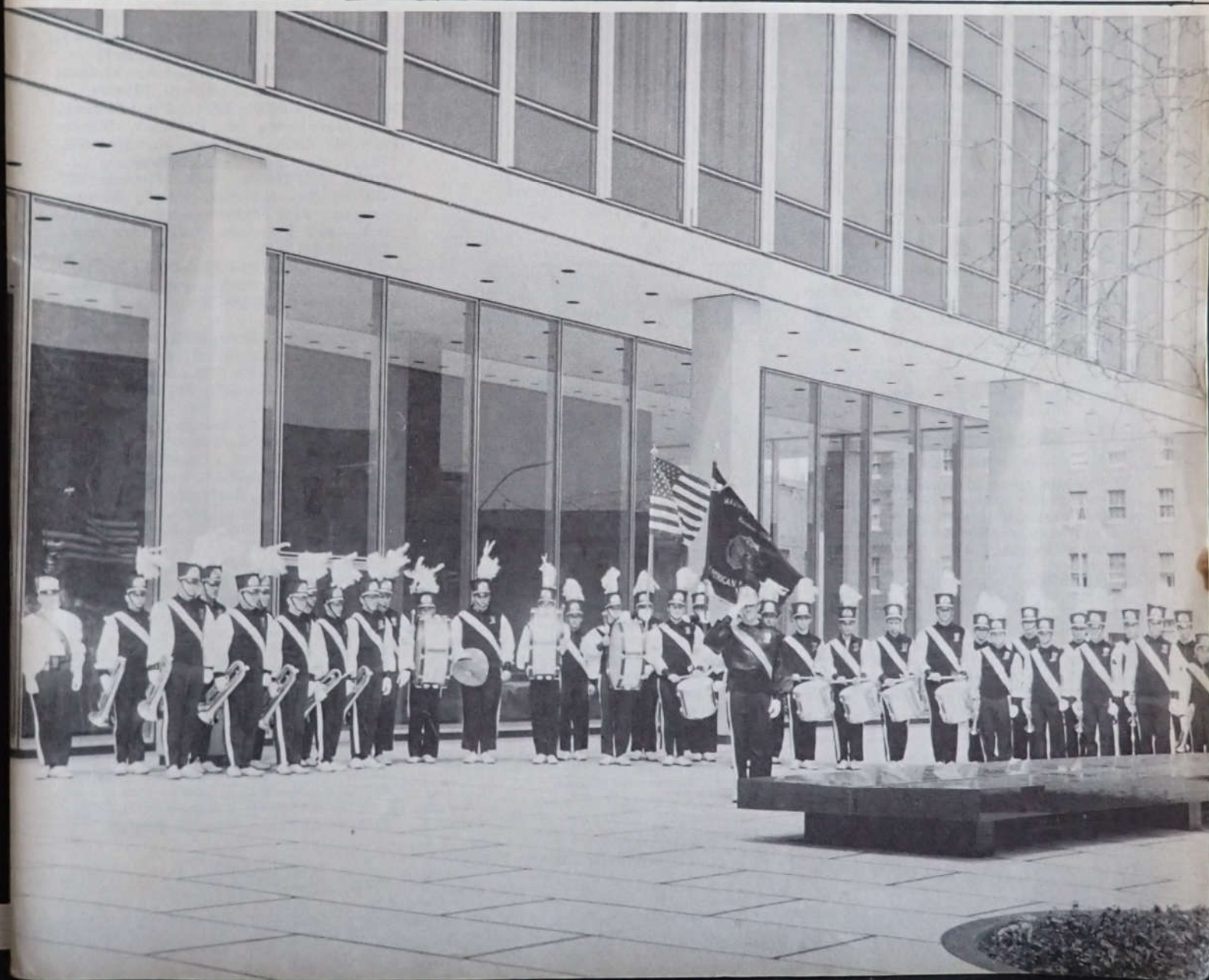

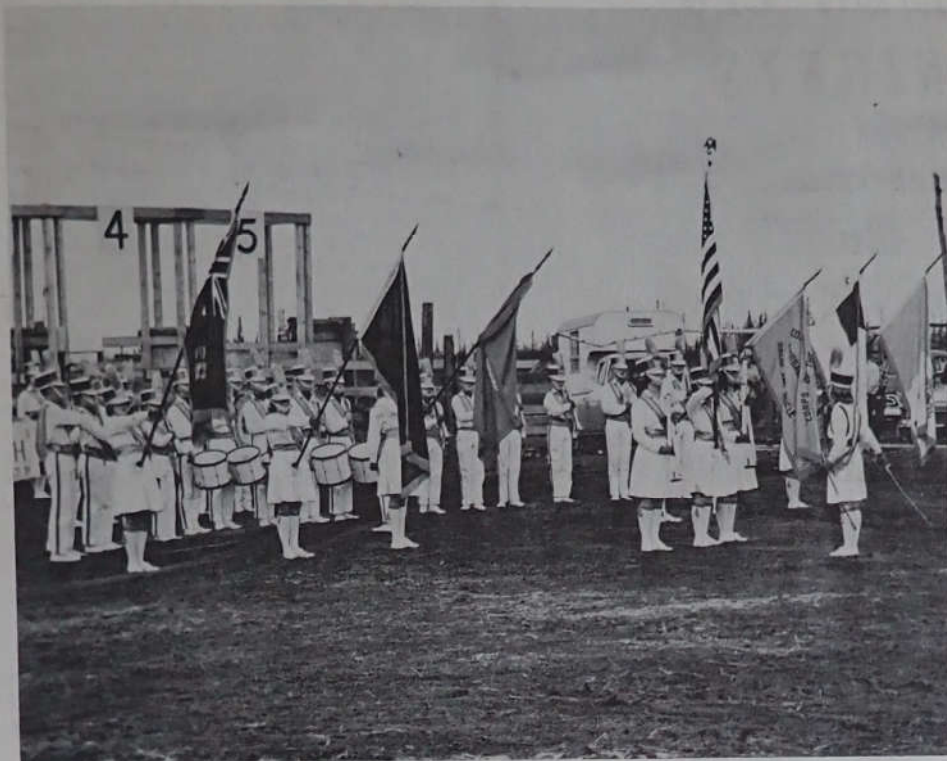

DATELINE FAIRBANKS, ALASKA.....

Recently, a devastating EARTHQUAKE struck the State of Alaska, and Alaskans felt the cold chill of death and destruction. Alaska's only drum corps, the "CORPS OF THE NORTH" from Fairbanks, was unharmed since the city of Fairbanks is located deep in the interior of the 49th State. The corps and their families immediately went to work on emergency projects to assist their sister cities Anchorage, Valdez, and Seward. Fairbanks was the center of evacuation for the cities of Seward and Valdez which were literally wiped off the map. Anchorage, Alaska's largest city, suffered tremendous property loss. The "Corps of the North," which last year made its first trip to a National Convention, (when they attended the 1963 VFW Convention in Seattle), had many plans for the coming season. Among those plans was the trip to Cleveland, Ohio for 1964 Nationals, and an additional trip to the New Yorks World Fair. As a result of the Earthquake's devastating blow to the States economy, the corps must relinquish its plans to attend the 1964 Nationals. Though this disaster has laid aside plans for this year, the Corps of the North plans to grow, "Bigger and Better" than ever in the face of the future that stands before them.
