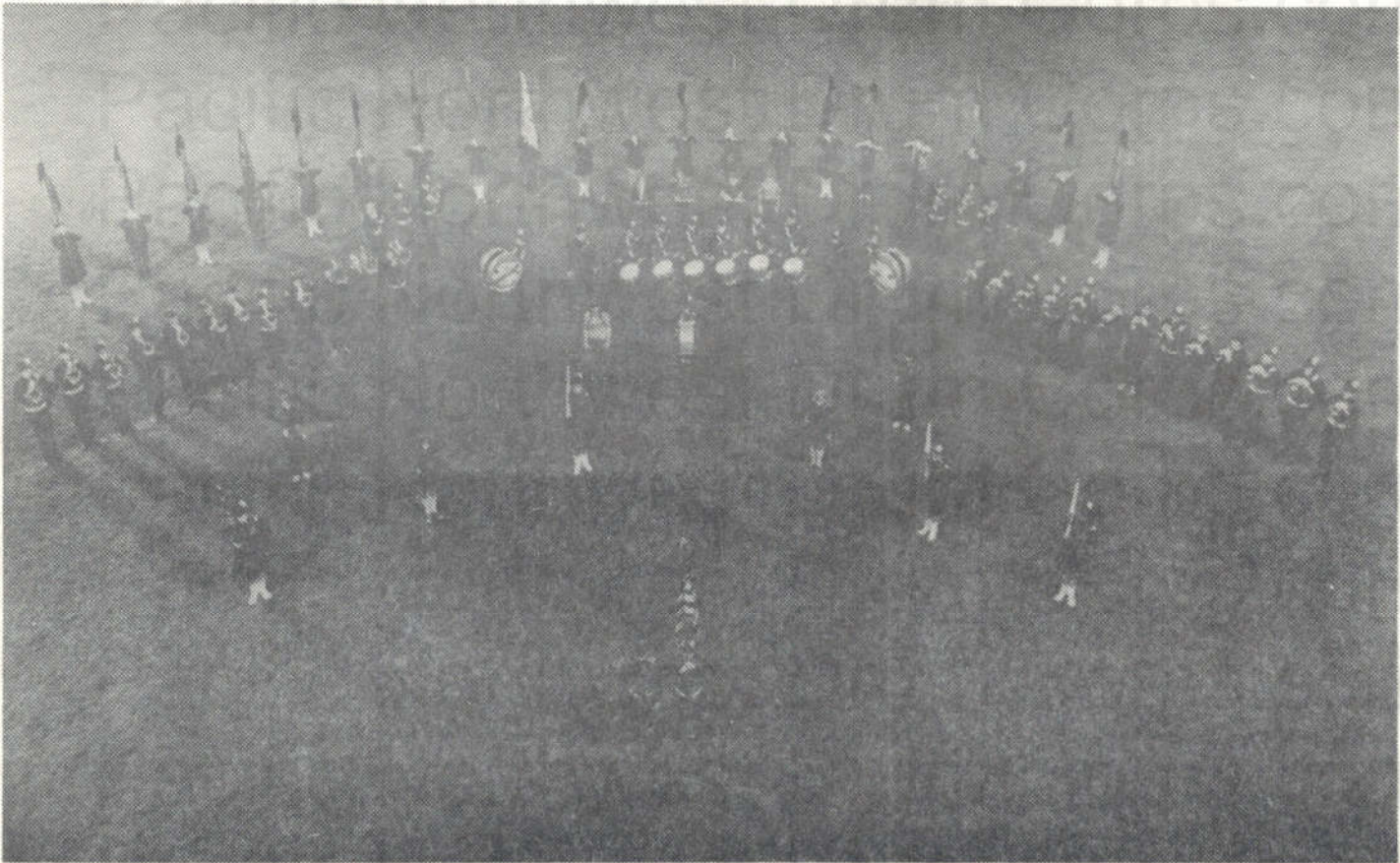

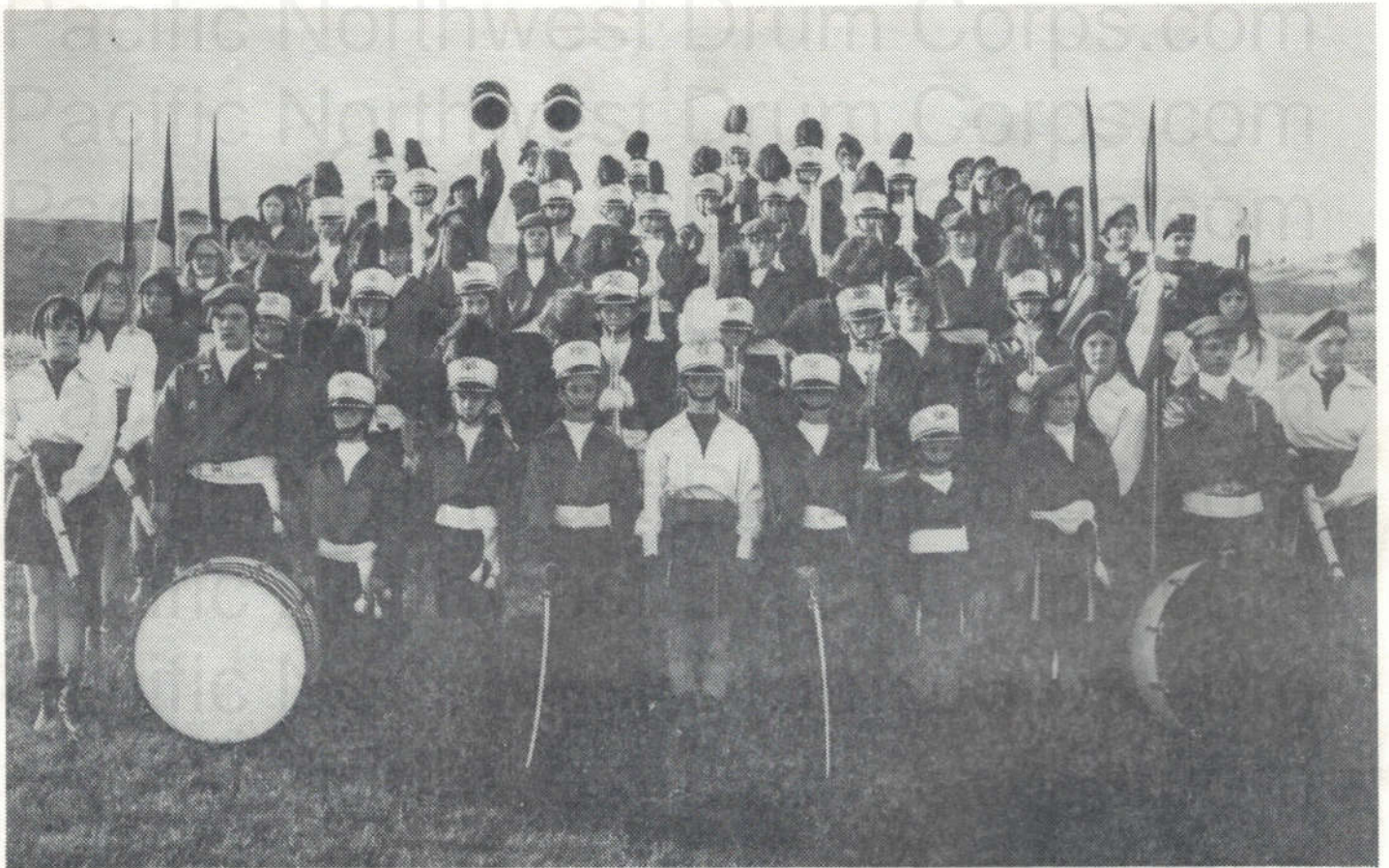

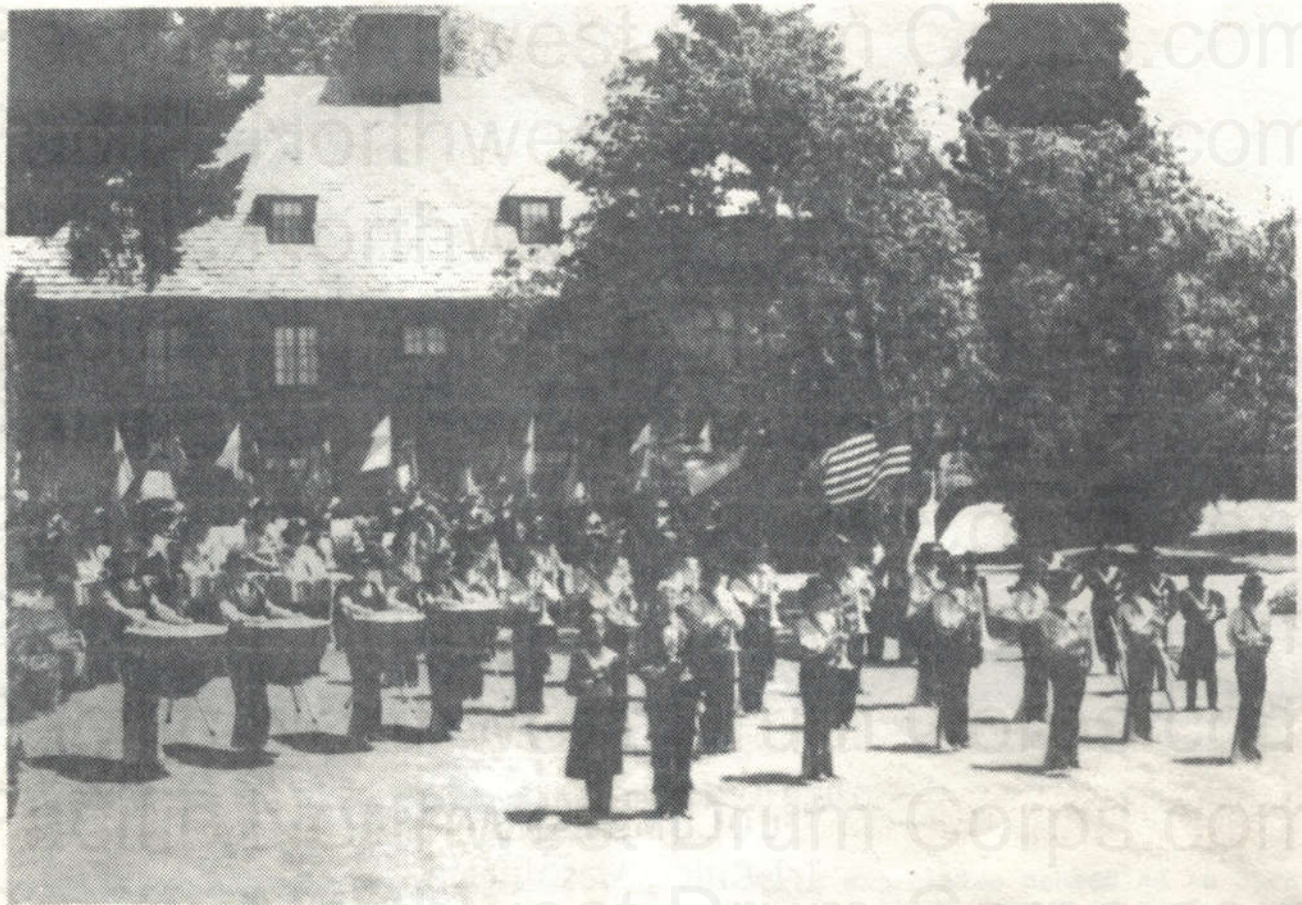

The Sentinels welcome you to the Brazen Brass and hope you enjoy the show.

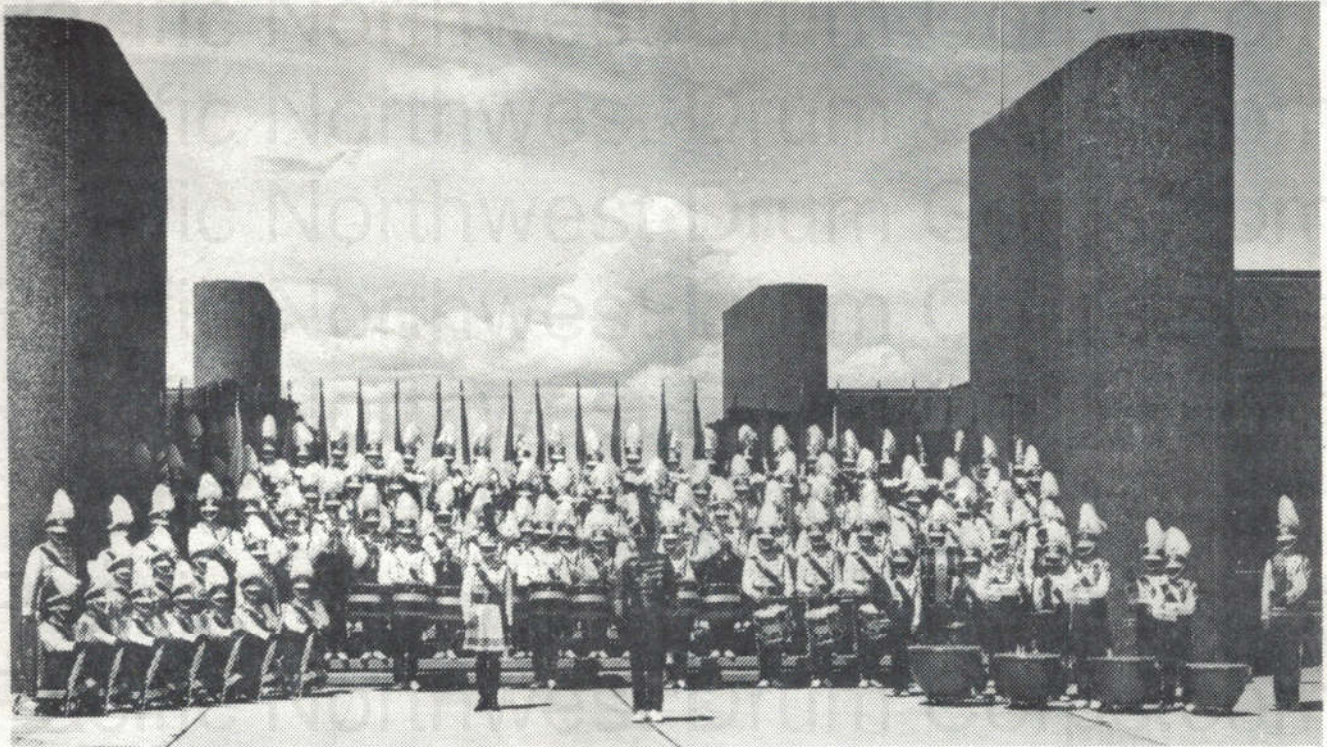
