Drum, Bugle Convention on Weekend

Seventy-six trombones may well be among the 500 to 1,000 participants expected in Stockton this weekend for the first Western States Drum and Bugle Corps convention.

Drum and bugle corps members from 11 Western states, including the entire Air Force Academy Drum and Bugle Corps, will attend the convention.

The weekend sessions will include clinics conducted by Don Angelica, of New Jersey; Don Pescone, a judge from the Central States Judging Association, and Frank Arsenault, a drum company representative.

A reception and registration will be held at 9 a.m. tomorrow in Civic Auditorium, followed by two days of clinics and a 6 p.m. dinner Sunday.

Contests are scheduled Sunday from 2:30 to 5 p.m. The Air Force Academy Drum and Bugle Corps will present a concert at 3:30 p.m. in Civic Auditorium.
